

Squib Class Broadland Regatta
26 - 27 March 2022

Notice of Race

Waveney & Oulton Broad Yacht Club (WOBYC) will be organizing the Broadlands Squib Regatta on 26 and 27 March 2022, and would like to extend an invitation to all Squib sailors.

The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing together with the prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association, the Rules of the National Squib Class and the Sailing Instructions for the Regatta.

The Regatta is open to all boats of the Squib Class, the owners and helmsmen of which are members of the National Squib Owners Association.

Entries must be made on the attached form and returned to the address thereon by **21 March 2022**. The entry fee needs to be paid by the same time.

There is no limit on the number of entries. It is intended that the event will be sailed in flights on Saturday, each boat sailing against every other boat at least once, with the fleet being divided between gold and silver fleets for the Sunday races.

The first warning signal will be at 11.25 on Saturday 26 March and at 10.25 on Sunday 27 March. No warning signal will be made after 13.30 on Sunday 27 March. There will be briefings at the Clubhouse at 10.45 on 26 March and at 09.45 on 27 March.

Each boat will score points equal to its finishing place in each race (The Low Points scoring system of RRS Appendix A shall apply). All races sailed in flights will be counted for the purpose of dividing the fleet into gold and silver fleets. Each boat will carry its overall position from the flight racing into the gold (top half of the fleet) or silver fleet and its overall position from Saturday will be added to its results on Sunday to arrive at its overall points total. There will be no discards in either series.

In the event that there are fewer entrants than expected for flight racing, there will instead be five fleet races (three on Saturday and two on Sunday). Each boats score will be the total of her race scores. There will be no discards.

The courses will be on Oulton Broad using the WOBYC club racing marks. The attention of all competitors is drawn to the Broads Authority regulations regarding boat tolls.

RRS44.1 is changed so that the Two Turns Penalty is replaced by a One Turn penalty.

Each competing boat shall be insured with minimum third-party cover of £2,000,000. Competitors compete in the Regatta entirely at their own risk.

Please bring plenty of warps and fenders and a lock for your trailer.

River Race Friday 25 March

At popular request, we have arranged a friendly river race for those arriving early for the Regatta. The warning signal for this will be at 11:25 on the Friday, following a briefing at the Clubhouse at 10.45. This will involve a race to the Waveney Inn at the Burgh St Peter Waveney River Centre, with a stop for lunch; and a race or sail back to WOBYC after appropriate refreshment.

Craneage

Craneage will be available using the WOBYC crane and we will have a team of volunteers arranged to assist. We are lucky that we can crane at most states of the tide but we recommend that anyone wishing to crane in on Saturday morning should arrive before 09.00. We will also arrange craneage for **Thursday afternoon** for those intending to take part in the River Race, and on **Friday afternoon**. Please indicate on your entry form when you expect to arrive so that we can assist. Only fully verified strops can be used, and the crane must only be used by fully trained W&OBYC members.

Entertainment

There is no formal meeting planned for the evening Friday 25th March, although there are a number of bars and restaurants within easy walking distance of WOBYC.

There will be a free snack available at WOBYC immediately after racing on Saturday and the bar will be open until approx. 18:30pm. In the evening, tables have been booked at the RN&SYC, about 2 miles away, from 19:00 onwards. Food and a bar will be available.

There will be a free buffet after racing on Sunday.

Accommodation

Oulton Broad is a popular holiday destination so there is plenty of reasonably priced accommodation available. The recommended option is RN&SYC, especially with the Saturday evening meal that has been booked there. Possible options are:
